1. On Tuesday, January 30, 2007, I received a list of Class Members ("Class Member List") with 35,449 names counsel for the defendant, Republic Mortgage Insurance Company ("RMIC"). The Class Member List included addresses.
2. Using the National Change of Address ("NCOA") database that is maintained by the United States Postal Service ("Postal Service"), I obtained updates to the addresses in the Class Member List.
3. With the cooperation and assistance of Class Counsel and counsel for RMIC, I formatted the Class Notice, Claim Form, and Class Brochure for mailing to Class Members.
4. On February 28, 2007, I mailed the Class Notice, together with the Claim Form and the Class Brochure, to Class Members, using the addresses as updated through the NCOA database. I mailed 35,449 Class Notices. In those cases of a Class Member with two or more Loans, I mailed a separate Class Notice, Claim Form, and Class Brochure for each Loan.

5. I received 3,352 Class Notices that were returned by the Postal Service as undeliverable. Of these, 150 included a forwarding address, to which I re-mailed the Class Notice, together with the Claim Form and Class Brochure. The remainder did not reflect a forwarding address, so I did not re-mail the Class Notice, Claim Form, and Class Brochure.

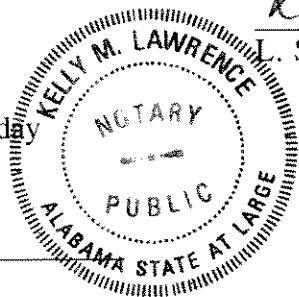
6. I received five (5) requests for exclusion from the Class on or before April 4, 2007, wherein the person requesting exclusion did (a) state his or her full name, address, and telephone number; (b) provide information reasonably identifying the Loan(s) as to which he or she sought exclusion; (c) contain the Class Member's original signature; and (d) unequivocally state the Class Member's intent to be excluded from the Settlement Class, to be excluded from the Settlement, not to participate in the Settlement, and/or to waive all right to the benefits of the Settlement. I have created a list of persons who successfully opt out of the class and have provided a copy of it to Counsel for the Defendant.

7. I have made arrangements to maintain an address for this Settlement for a period of one hundred twenty (120) days after the Final Approval Date, for the purpose of receiving (a) Claim Forms that are returned, whether valid or not, and (b) other inquiries with respect to the Settlement.
